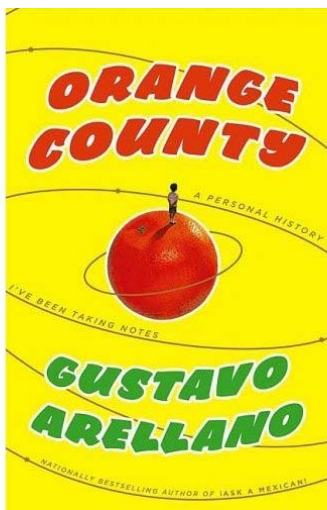


Friends of the Library Book Fair at Barnes & Noble November 14th & 15th Gustavo Arellano to Speak on the 14th

For this fundraiser a percentage of sales during these two days will be donated to the Friends of the Fullerton College Library whenever the Friends voucher is presented at time of purchase.

The Barnes & Noble Bookstore is located in the Amerige Heights Town Center at 1923 West Malvern Ave. in Fullerton and is open from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. each day. The vouchers needed to credit a portion of each sale to the Friends can be



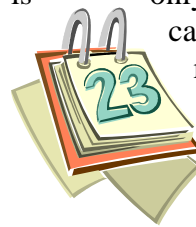
obtained either on the reverse of this newsletter or at the Library Circulation Desk or Cadena/Transfer Center on the Fullerton College campus.

The centerpiece of the event will occur on November 14th at 12:30 p.m. when Gustavo Arellano will speak. Arellano is author of two books, *Ask a Mexican* and *Orange County: A Personal History*, and columnist for the *OC Weekly*. Coincidentally, Mr. Arellano's *Orange County* book has been selected by Fullerton College for the One Book, One College program this year. Mr. Arellano will be discussing his books and newspaper column and will be answering questions and signing his books. The afternoon promises to be interesting and stimulating. Mr. Arellano is an entertaining and humorous speaker.

Orange County's Native Speaker: Gustavo Arellano

Author Gustavo Arellano is a frequent speaker around Orange County and will be featured at the Friends Book Fair at Barnes & Noble in Fullerton on November 14th (See feature story). A native



of Anaheim and columnist for the *OC Weekly*. Arellano's second book, *Orange County: A Personal History* has also been chosen as the One Book One College selection for Fullerton College for 2009-10. The book is a mixture of memoir, tracing the history of his family's immigration to Orange County from Mexico, with a history of Orange County. Arellano relates the story of his great-grandfather's arrival in 1918 to pick fruit in the local orange groves, the family's subsequent struggles with racism and assimilation, and his own experiences growing up in Anaheim. These chapters on his family are alternated with chapters on the history of "the O.C." from rancheros to Republicans.

Arellano is also a contributing editor to the *L.A. Times* and a frequent guest on local television and radio shows.

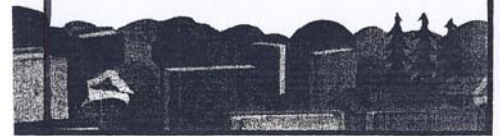
