If the article has no author, start the citation with the title. The Fullerton College Library has many databases produced by EBSCO; each EBSCO database that is used must be cited. For popular magazines (e.g., *Time*, *Newsweek*, *Nation*) you do not need the volume number; for scholarly journals you will need the volume number and issue number (if provided).

Citation information on this database will be at the start of each reference source (e.g., dictionary, encyclopedia, handbook, etc.) entry. If there is no author for the entry, start with the title.

## **NETLIBRARY**

NetLibrary is a database of electronic or e-books published first in a paper/print or online version, then reprinted or republished on the NetLibrary database. Information about a printed or online book is cited first, followed by the NetLibrary database.

Click on Statistics Summary to find the author or agency responsible for the data; the date is the last date of the compiled statistical data.
