### Articles from Journals, Magazines, or Newspapers (7.01)

Print	
<b>Author(s).</b>	Lastname, Firstinitial., Lastname, Firstinitial, & Lastname, Firstinitial.
<b>(Year, Month Day).</b>	Include month and day if available.
<b>Title of article.</b>	Only the first word and proper nouns are capitalized (sentence case).
<b>Title of Journal or Magazine,</b>	All main words are capitalized (title case) in italics,
<b>Volume number</b>	If available.
<b>(issue number),</b>	If available, and pagination is not continuous.
<b>Pages.</b>	If available. For newspapers, include p. and pp., e.g., p. B2 and pp. C1, C3-C4.

<b>DOI or URL. Ask your instructors which method they prefer:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. DOI number: Retrieved from <a href="https://doi.org/...">https://doi.org/...</a></li> <li>2. Publisher's homepage URL: Retrieved from <a href="http://...">http://...</a></li> <li>3. Permalink or stable URL to article: Retrieved from <a href="http://...">http://...</a></li> </ol>

<b>Editor(s).</b>	Include if book has author(s) and editor(s).
<b>(Translator).</b>	If work is a translation, include translator: (C. K. Scott Moncrieff, Trans.).
<b>(Edition).</b>	If other than first, include edition: (5 <sup>th</sup> ed.).
<b>Location:</b>	E.g., Chicago, IL:
<b>Publisher.</b>	E.g., University of Chicago Press.
Online	
<b>Permalink or URL</b>	E.g., Retrieved from <a href="http://ezproxy.fcclib.nocccd.edu...">http://ezproxy.fcclib.nocccd.edu...</a>
Republished Work	
<b>(Original work year published)</b>	E.g., (Original work published 1903)

<b>Author(s) or Editor(s) if no author.</b>	Lastname, Firstinitial., & Lastname, Firstinitial. (Eds.).
<b>(Year, Month Date).</b>	If no date, write (n.d.).
<b>Title of work</b>	Only the first word and proper nouns are capitalized (sentence case), in italics
<b>(Report Number).</b>	(Report No. xxx), if included.
Location	
<b>Publisher.</b>	Include if retrieved online unless publisher is also the author. E.g., Washington, DC: Government Printing Office.
<b>URL</b>	E.g., Retrieved from <a href="http://www.websiteurlhere">http://www.websiteurlhere</a>

<b>Author(s) or Editor(s) if no author.</b>	Lastname, Firstinitial., & Lastname, Firstinitial. (Eds.).
<b>(Year, Month Date).</b>	If no date, write (n.d.).
<b>Title of web page or post</b>	Only the first word and proper nouns are capitalized (sentence case)
<b>[Format description].</b>	E.g., [Blog post] or [Video file].
<b>Retrieved from URL</b>	Full URL

Note: When referencing an entire website, it is enough to include the website title and URL in the text of your paper. You do not need to also include the citation in the reference list.

References should be: 1) in alphabetical order by author's last name, 2) 12-point font in Times New Roman, 3) double spaced, 4) with a ½-inch hanging indent (in MS Word: Highlight citations > select Paragraph > Indentation: Special: Hanging, By: 0.5").
