- Large, greater than 24\*36 (winner \$100 gift card /honorable mention \$75 gift card)
- No submission fee.
- 3-D works must have a stable base or flat bottom. Mobiles accepted if ready to hang.
- 2-D works must be ready to hang: no wet work, works on paper must be matted or mounted, indicate top of work (if unclear), no sawtooth clips.
- Presentation of work must be secure and stable.
- Students should completely fill out entry form.
- Original entries only.
- Include name, email, phone number, and postal address with submission.
- Open only to entries from current FC students.
- The winning art pieces will be selected by a panel of judges and housed in the library.
- Winning art pieces will become the property of the library.
- Deadline is 3:45pm, Friday, Nov. 8, 2024, at FCL's circulation desk.
